LIS 506: Research Methods for Library and Information Professionals	Research methodology, research design, and elementary statistics.
LIS 515: Organization of Information	Introduction to the theories and practices used in the organization of information. Overview of national and international standards and practices for access to information in collections.
LIS 520: Ethics for Library and Information Professionals	Study of the basics of ethical theory and its application to problems in information management. Application and development of ethical codes in cases studies.
